- Why do we have marine reserves?
- An investment by the state to track changes in:
 - Nearshore ecological communities
 - Economic, social, and cultural influences in fishing and coastal communities




How were marine reserves in Oregon established?



- Local communities worked with state officials to determine reserve sites.
- Sites target ecological benefits and avoid negative community impacts.

What is the 2023 Legislative Review?

- In 2012, the Oregon legislature mandated a check-in for the Marine Reserves Program in 2023.
- As part of this process:
 - ODFW wrote a synthesis report summarizing the first 10 years of implementation
 - An Oregon-based university team evaluated the program and made recommendations
 - The Science and Technical Advisory Committee (STAC) will provide a summary of the recommendations to the legislature by March 1, 2023
- The Oregon legislature currently has House Bill 2903 under consideration to implement recommendations.
 - Recommendations **do not** include *new* marine reserve sites, but do include new program elements
